I am still hoping to get both of these clubs chartered before year end.

District 6 is over 1400 membership payments short to achieve the membership goal. That will decrease over the next month as more dues are paid to Toastmasters International from current clubs making late payments due to the coronavirus.

12 club coaches were placed during the year to help struggling clubs.

I would like to thank team members Marvel Kummer, Laura Bathke and Vince Bullinger for helping with new club mentors/sponsors, club coaches and demo meetings.
