





Block 1: Quality Meetings

- Meetings are scheduled in advance
- Communication Tree is utilized to confirm meeting roles
- Members attend and are prepared for their roles
- Speeches are from projects in manuals
- Table Topics
- Effective evaluations are given








Block 2: Effective Evaluations

- Treat an evaluation as a short speech
- Express things YOU noticed
- Pay attention to the objectives of project
- Note use of rhetorical devices (alliteration, triads, etc), grammar, and unique language
- Be sure to provide 1 or 2 items for improvement
- Be sure to begin and end with things you liked about the speech
